| 12. ESK VALLEY SAUVIGNON BLANC<br>Marlborough, New Zealand<br><i>A dry and complex combination of herbaceous and ripe tropical fruit flavours with a long, refreshing finish.</i>   | £29    |
| 13. RIOJA VEGA BLANCO, Rioja, Spain <br><i>White Rioja is much underrated – but becoming more popular and we urge you to give it a try. It has aromas of conference pear, white flowers and limey notes.</i>   | £27    |
| 14. SHARPHAM DART VALLEY RESERVE <br>Devon, England<br><i>If you're putting an English wine on your list in the style of Sauvignon... then this has to be the one! Ripe, peachy fruit with a balanced acidity. This is THE new World of Wines ...so take note!</i> | £29    |

| 30. SMART DOG SYRAH, Alentejo, Portugal<br><i>You should try this for the label alone – selected for our K9 lovers (and others!) All wine makers have tales to tell about their wines ... this one is no different. A 'smart' dog indicated to his owner, where to plant these vines that produce wine of a deep ruby colour, with a rich nose of creamed black fruits and sweet spice.</i> | £29    |
| 31. LAUTARUL PINOT NOIR, Cramele Recas, Romania <br><i>Fragrant and fruity with plenty of ripe red fruits with hints of spice. After much investment Romania is now producing award winning quality wines, definitely worth a try – especially if you enjoy Pinot Noir.</i>                            | £25    |
| 32. PRIMITIVO APPASSIMENTO CARLOMAGNO <br>Puglia, Italy<br><i>From the heel of Italy, this vineyard dries some of the fruit to give a complex depth with delightful flavours.</i>  | £27    |
| 33. OLD VINES CARIGNAN, COQUILLE DE TERRE <br>Southern France<br><i>A really startling and profoundly enjoyable red with lush fruits and soft integrated tannins. The grapes for this wine come from old Carignan vines, some of which are up to 80 years old.</i>                                     | £26    |

*Dry and Fruity palate with gooseberry and guava. Great example of its varietal.*
3. PINOT GRIGIO CA'TESORE Italy  
*Zing! A delightful expressive, dry wine – it's the Italian Job!*

#### Rosé

4. COQUILLE DE FLEUR CINSAULT ROSÉ   
*Languedoc-Roussillon  
Coquille de Fleur Rosé epitomises everything one loves about the South of France lifestyle! Fruit-forward and vibrant.*

5. ANGELS FLIGHT ZINFANDEL, USA  
*Aromas of strawberry and watermelon – well balanced with a crisp finish.*
